PREFACE

1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Land Dispute

The Maweni Settlement Scheme in Mtwapa within Kilifi County has been the epicenter of a protracted land dispute spanning over 22 years. The controversy revolves around two parcels of land, numbered MN/III/324 and MN/III/334, which collectively cover 161 hectares in the Maweni Settlement Scheme of Kilifi South Constituency, Kilifi South Sub-County. The land has been home to approximately 1,401 families, many of whom have resided there for decades.

According to the community, the land had been leased to four white settlers as a reward after the Second World War. They started surrendering the titles in 1971. The community later moved into the parcel of land and settled after the land was left undeveloped. Philemon Mwaisaka acquired this title fraudulently in 1989.

In 2004, the Maweni community had sought justice through the legal system, filing High Court Case No. 64 of 2004 to resolve the land dispute. However, in a shocking act of betrayal, a suspicious consent agreement was secretly signed in 2008 between two lawyers—Mr. Okanga (representing the petitioners) and Mrs. Wameyo (representing the defendants)—without the knowledge or approval of the Maweni community members. This backroom deal undermined the community's fight for land tenure, raising serious questions about collusion, legal malpractice, and the denial of justice. The fact that their representatives acted without their consent only deepened the squatters' mistrust of a system that was supposed to protect their rights.

In 2017, the government initiated a survey of the land under the Maweni Settlement Initiative, aiming to formalize land ownership by allocating plots measuring 50 by 100 meters to each resident. Despite these efforts, by mid-2023, only 15 title deeds had been issued, leaving over 1,300 families uncertain. Allegations surfaced that some of the allocated titles were granted to non-residents and influential individuals, sidelining the legitimate occupants. ([Nation Africa, 2023](#))

The situation escalated on June 6th, 2023, when the Ministry of Lands and Physical Planning was ordered by the Environment and Lands Court in Malindi to halt the issuance of title deeds. In his ruling, Justice Makori ordered the respondents to stop further allocation, alienation, and issuance of title deeds until the correct application was heard. This injunction came after residents filed a petition protesting the alleged irregular titling process that favored outsiders over genuine beneficiaries.

Tensions further intensified in late 2023, culminating in violent confrontations. The residents accused unscrupulous land grabbers, purportedly in collusion with certain police officers and vigilante groups, of attempting to evict them forcibly. These clashes tragically resulted in casualties, including the death of a local youth on 12th December 2023. The family of the victim was threatened when they went to report to the police station.

As of early 2025, the dispute remains unresolved, with many residents still awaiting the formalization of their land rights. The community continues to advocate for transparent and equitable land allocation processes to ensure that the rightful occupants receive legal recognition and protection of their land rights.

1.2 Purpose and Scope of Fact-Finding Mission

The fact-finding mission to the Maweni Settlement Scheme, Mtwapa, Kilifi South Constituency, aimed to assess the ongoing land dispute over parcels titled MN/III/324 and MN/III/334. The aim was to establish the current status of the dispute, investigate the historical background and legal standing of the disputed 161-hectare land, identify key stakeholders, historical injustice, and document squatters' grievances, experiences, and recommendations. It assessed the social and economic impact of the dispute on residents. Secondly, it evaluated the land titling and allocation process, examining allegations of irregularities, favoritism, and illegal land allocations.

It also aimed to investigate security and human rights concerns, including violent confrontations, forced evictions, and alleged police involvement. The findings were compiled into a comprehensive report, serving as a reference for advocacy, legal action, and policy recommendations to secure fair and just land ownership for the affected residents of Maweni.

2.0 METHODOLOGY

2.1 Data Collection Methods

Multiple data collection methods were employed to ensure a comprehensive understanding of the Maweni Settlement Scheme land dispute. These methods aimed to gather first-hand accounts, verify historical records, and assess the current situation on the ground.

Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) were conducted with the squatters to capture their first-hand experiences regarding the land dispute. The squatters were grouped into sets of eight, ensuring the inclusion of women and youth to reflect diverse perspectives. These discussions provided valuable insights into the history of the settlement, grievances over land ownership, the allocation process, and the factors contributing to the current stalemate. Through these interactive sessions, the fact-finding team was able to document personal testimonies that highlighted the deep-seated concerns of the affected residents.

Document (desktop & physical) reviews were carried out to verify the legal and administrative history of the disputed land. Key documents examined included the court ruling dated March 30, 2012, which declared parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 as public land. The 2017 list of beneficiaries, compiled by the National Land Commission (NLC), was also analyzed to assess how land allocations were handled. Additional legal records, including court orders and rulings related to the 2023 conservatory order (ELC 20/2023), halting the issuance of title deeds, were reviewed to establish the legitimacy of land claims and disputes raised by residents. These documents helped provide a factual basis for understanding the legal issues surrounding the case.

Site visits and field observations were conducted to gain a first-hand understanding of the physical and environmental context of the disputed land. The team visited the Maweni Settlement Scheme to assess the location of the land and its vicinity. Observations focused on land use, current occupancy, ongoing construction, and the general state of infrastructure in the area. Additionally, the site visits helped in verifying the proximity of the land to public utilities, roads, and other developments that may have contributed to the dispute. The physical presence of the team on the ground also allowed for interactions with residents, further validating the claims and concerns raised during FGDs.

Key informant interviews (KIIs) were conducted with community members who hold critical knowledge about the dispute. These interviews included local leaders and land rights activists who

provided insights into government policies, legal interpretations, and ongoing efforts to resolve the conflict. Discussions with residents who had faced eviction threats or legal battles offered a deeper perspective on the human rights impact of the dispute. By engaging with these key informants, the fact-finding mission was able to piece together a well-rounded view of the situation, ensuring that both policy-level and community-level perspectives were captured.

Storytelling conducted through photography and videography was used as an additional method to document the current situation on the ground. The team captured images and video footage of key areas within the disputed land, including existing settlements, ongoing developments, and sites of past evictions. This visual evidence provided an objective reference for understanding the extent of land occupation, infrastructural developments, and the residents' interactions. The documentation also aimed to support advocacy efforts by presenting a clear and factual representation of the dispute.

2.2 Sources of Information

The fact-finding mission gathered information from a variety of primary and secondary sources to ensure an accurate and well-rounded understanding of the Maweni Settlement Scheme land dispute.

Residents' perspectives were obtained through focus group discussions (FGDs) conducted with residents of Maweni. One participant shared, *"We have lived on this land for decades, yet we still have no title deeds. Every time we hear of land allocation, we are sidelined in favor of outsiders."* These discussions provided personal testimonies on the history of the settlement, the allocation process, and grievances related to the dispute.

Legal and administrative records were reviewed to establish the status of land ownership and past rulings. Among the key documents examined was the court ruling dated March 30, 2012, which declared parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 as public land. The 2017 list of beneficiaries, compiled by the National Land Commission (NLC), was also analyzed, with one participant stating, *"Many of us were listed as beneficiaries in 2017, but we still have not received any official ownership documents."* Additional legal records, including the 2023 injunction halting the issuance of title deeds, were reviewed to understand the ongoing legal battles.

Field observations from site visits were another critical source of information. The mission team visited Maweni to verify the location, current occupancy, and ongoing developments on the disputed land. One of the team members noted, *"Many families already occupy the land, but we also observed new developments that suggest possible private acquisitions."* These visits provided a physical context to the dispute and validated claims made by residents.

Insights from key informant interviews (KIIs) were also instrumental in understanding the broader legal and policy context. Interviews with local leaders and land rights activists revealed inconsistencies in the land allocation process. A land rights activist stated, *"The Maweni land issue is a clear case of land grabbing facilitated by loopholes in the titling process. The 2012 ruling declared this as public land, yet private developers continue to claim ownership."*

Visual documentation, including photographs and video recordings taken during the field visits, served as important sources of evidence. These images captured the current state of the land, infrastructural developments, and residents' interactions, helping to validate testimonies gathered during Focus Group Discussions and Key Informant Interviews.

3.0 FINDINGS

The fact-finding mission to the Maweni Settlement Scheme, Mtwapa, Kilifi South Constituency, revealed critical insights into the ongoing land dispute over parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334, covering 161 hectares. The findings are categorized into four key areas: historical context, current situation, squatters' perspectives, and legal framework

3.1 Historical Context

The Maweni Settlement Scheme has been home to hundreds of families for several decades, with many residents tracing their settlement back to the pre-independence and early post-independence periods. Initially, it was believed to be public land, with families settling informally over the years, engaging in farming, business, and residential development.

In 1971, the white settlers who were the occupants of the land surrendered it to the government. Philemon Mwaisaka acquired the titles in 1989 fraudulently, claiming he was awarded the parcel by President Moi. By this time the community had started settling in.

In 2003, a committee was formed to represent the community. They later filed a court case against Mwaisaka. In 2007, demolitions were ordered by Philemon Mwaisaka, who claimed ownership of the parcel of land after the residents took him to court over the disputed property. They had been struggling with him over the land since the early 2000s. According to the Maweni Self-help group, further demolitions occurred in 2009, where residents' houses were demolished by Mwaisaka's order in the presence of hired goons who provided security for the demolitions.

In 2012, a High Court ruling declared the land public, reinforcing the position amongst residents that they were rightful occupants. However, despite this ruling, disputes over ownership persisted, with private developers and other entities laying claim to portions of the land. The issue of land tenure insecurity in Maweni reflects a broader historical pattern in Kilifi County and the coastal region at large, where land ownership has often been contested due to irregular allocations, lack of proper titling, and competing claims between settlers and private entities.

In 2017, the National Lands Commission began the process of surveying and settling the community under the Maweni Settlement Scheme. This process was conducted with NLC officers but without community participation or a gazette notice as required by the constitution. A seventeen-member committee was established by MP Ken Chonga and led by Lewis Mchai;

however, the residents later discovered that the committee was acting in favor of the land grabbers. The committee included four siblings- Omar Salim Chengo, Hussein Kitsao Chengo, Juma Nimasumbi, and Juma Omar Nguma- as well as Jane Muche and her daughter June Ruth. This indicated a total disregard for the community's involvement in the survey process and the lack of inclusivity in the committee.

3.2 Current Situation

The dispute over parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 remains unresolved, with rising tensions amongst residents, developers, and government agencies. The fact-finding mission observed that some sections of the land have been occupied for years, while other parts are now subject to new private development projects. Some parts are also undeveloped due to the legal standoff. There have been demolitions before and multiple eviction threats, with some residents reporting intimidation by private developers and law enforcement agencies.

Field visits confirmed ongoing construction and fencing of certain portions of the land, indicating active private claims despite the 2012 High Court judgement declaring it public. Additionally, reports emerged of land transactions taking place without clear legal backing, raising concerns over possible land grabbing and fraudulent allocations. Residents also expressed frustration over government inaction, as previous land surveys and regularization efforts have not translated into formal ownership documents for long-term settlers. On 6th June 2023, in Case No. ELC/MLD/002-6/23, the Environment and Lands Court in Malindi ordered that respondents stop allocation, alienation, and issuance of title deeds and any other activity until the correct application is heard. This order has been ignored as there is ongoing construction on the piece of land.

Some residents have been arrested and charged with trumped-up offences. In Case No. E689/2024, 15 residents were arrested and charged with assault causing bodily harm, and the case was scheduled for mention on 6th September 2024. On that date, the charges were changed to robbery with violence, and no charge sheet was filed in court. In Case No. E791/2024, Gabriel Nyamawi, Fidelis Lur, and six other residents were arrested and charged with arson. The respondents are out on bail as the case waits for a mention date. Several cases relating to assault, murder, and harassment by the developers have been reported at Mtwapa Police Station. OB 62/3/5/2024 of assault is still being processed at the office of the Director of Public Prosecutions since May 2024,

while OB numbers 75/8/7/2014 and 49/30/1/2024 are yet to be processed, even though residents are ready to provide statements.

3.3 Community's Perspective

The residents remain deeply concerned about the future of their land ownership and livelihoods. Many residents argue that they have lived on the land for generations, yet they continue to face insecurity and threats of eviction. One resident noted, *"We have built our homes and raised our children here, yet every few years, new landowners come with court orders claiming ownership."*

Women and youth were particularly vocal about the impact of the dispute, highlighting issues such as loss of economic stability, psychological distress, and the disruption of social services. Many residents emphasized that their attempts to engage with local and national authorities have yielded little success, leading to a sense of abandonment and hopelessness. Additionally, the 2017 National Land Commission (NLC) survey, which listed beneficiaries, was seen as a positive step, but many lamented that no formal titles have been issued since

The community is also seeking the current title deeds of the parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 to be revoked so that the process of subdivision and allocation can be done properly. The community feels that this is the only way that the rightful occupants can get their land.

On December 12, 2023, Hassan Ngoka was brutally killed at Maweni by individuals well-known to the community, all in plain sight of police officers from Mtwapa Station. Shockingly, the family was barred from reporting the incident at the Mtwapa Police Station. Instead, officers hastily removed the body, took it to the Coast General Mortuary, and deliberately registered it under a false name. To further distort the facts, the police dressed Hassan's body in a police uniform, falsely claiming he had posed as an officer. However, the community had already captured photos of Hassan in his own clothes at the moment of his death—irrefutable proof of the police's deception.

To date, the Mtwapa Police Station has ignored Hassan's killing. Disturbingly, the community later discovered that the DCI Boss at Mtwapa Station, along with other officials, are beneficiaries of the disputed Maweni land. This conflict of interest explains their refusal to enforce court orders and their collaboration with armed gangs—operating under the guise of "community policing"—to deny locals access to their security of tenure.

3.4 Legal Framework

The legal status of MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 is shaped by multiple rulings and government interventions. The March 30, 2012, High Court (Misc. Application No 560 of 2004) judgement declared the land public, which should have provided a basis for formal settlement. The court declared that the parcel land known as Plot No. 324 and Plot 334 will be held in trust by the government for the applicant and other residents in possession of the land. However, subsequent legal battles and claims by private developers have complicated the implementation of this decision.

The 2017 NLC survey sought to identify legitimate beneficiaries, but the issuance of titles stalled, leading to renewed conflicts. In 2023, an injunction was issued, further preventing the processing of land documents and leaving residents in legal limbo. The Ministry of Lands and the National Lands Commission have been slow to provide clear directives, contributing to uncertainty and escalating tensions.

While constitutional provisions in Article 40 of the Kenyan Constitution protect land rights, the practical enforcement of these protections remains weak in Maweni. Article 67 of the Constitution of Kenya mandates the National Lands Commission to investigate complaints of present and historical land injustices, but little has been done by the commission to address the matter. Additionally, land governance policies, including the Community Land Act, have not been effectively implemented to resolve the dispute. The presence of conflicting land titles and claims of fraudulent land allocations further complicates the legal landscape, requiring urgent intervention from the judiciary, county government, and the National Land Commission.

4.0 CORE ISSUES

The Maweni Settlement Scheme land dispute is based on the data collected through Focus Group Discussions, document reviews, site visits, Key Informant Interviews, and visual documentation. The key issues identified revolve around land ownership conflicts, human rights violations, and legal inconsistencies. The analysis further examines the strength of the available evidence and the social and economic impact of the dispute on affected communities.

4.1 Identification of Core Issues

The Maweni land dispute presents several legal, social, and human rights concerns, which have contributed to uncertainty, tension, and fear, and the potential displacement of long-term settlers. The core issues identified include: -

1. Land ownership Uncertainty and Conflicting Claims

While the 2012 High Court judgement declared parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 as public land, private developers have continued to claim ownership, leading to persistent disputes. The 2017 National Land Commission (NLC) survey identified beneficiaries, but formal ownership documents were never issued, creating a legal limbo for residents. Reports of irregular allocations and fraudulent land transactions have further complicated the issue, raising concerns about land grabbing.

2. Human Rights Violations

Right to property ownership. (*Article 40 of the Kenyan Constitution*) The community reported evictions and demolitions of their properties and other multiple threats. The demolitions and evictions violated the protection of the right to property.

Right to life (*Article 26 of the Kenyan Constitution*); The killing of Hassan Ngo'ka on December 12, 2023, by known people, and the cover-up of his murder by the police violated his right to life. The case is still not solved to date because the police officers refused to book the crime, a blatant disregard for the right to life.

Right to Adequate Housing and Protection from Forced Evictions (*Article 43 of the Kenyan Constitution*); Residents reported threats of eviction and intimidation from private developers and

public administration officers violating their right to security of tenure. Some families have been evicted without due process, while others live in fear of displacement.

Right to Fair Administrative Action (*Article 47 of the Kenyan Constitution*): The lack of transparency in land allocation and the failure to implement the 2012 court ruling have denied residents access to fair and just administrative processes.

Right to Participate in Decision-Making (*Article 10 on Public Participation*): Many residents were excluded from key decisions regarding land allocation and title issuance. When the 2017 survey was done by the National Lands Commission, the community was not involved, nor called for public participation.

3. Weak Implementation of Court Orders and Land Policies

The 2012 ruling declaring the land public has not been enforced, raising concerns about the selective implementation of court decisions. Government agencies, including the Ministry of Lands and the Kilifi County Government, have failed to provide clear directives on land regularization. The Community Land Act and the National Land Commission's mandate have not been effectively applied to resolve the dispute.

4. Economic and Social Disruptions

Many residents cannot develop their land due to ownership uncertainty, affecting business growth, investment, and community development. Schools, health centers, and other public services are affected, with some facilities under threat of demolition due to competing land claims. Women and youth, particularly those engaged in informal businesses, are at risk of losing their livelihoods due to instability.

4.2 Assessment of Evidence

The strength of the available evidence is critical in determining the legitimacy of various claims and the potential for a lasting resolution. The fact-finding mission examined evidence from multiple sources:

1. Legal Documents and Court Rulings

The 2012 High Court ruling, which declared the land public, provides strong legal backing for the community's claims. However, a lack of enforcement has weakened its impact. The 2017 NLC list of beneficiaries gives credibility to settlers' land rights, but its non-implementation leaves

residents vulnerable. The 2023 injunction further complicates the dispute as it prevents the issuance of titles, delaying resolution.

2. Historical Settlement Patterns

Testimonies from long-term residents provide strong anecdotal evidence that families have lived on the land for decades, reinforcing their claim to occupancy rights. Visual documentation from photographs and videos captures ongoing developments, helping validate claims of intimidation and eviction threats.

3. Physical Observations and Site Visits

Field visits confirmed that some sections of the land remain occupied, while others are under new and ongoing development, suggesting active land transactions despite legal disputes and court orders. Evidence of new fencing and ongoing construction indicates that private claims are being pursued, even though the land is legally classified as public.

4. Testimonies from Legal Experts

Interviews with land rights activists confirm inconsistencies in land administration, with allegations of corruption and procedural irregularities in past allocations.

Legal experts highlighted gaps in policy implementation, with multiple overlapping claims making the case more complex.

4.3 Impact Analysis

The ongoing dispute has had far-reaching consequences on social stability, economic development, and access to public services in Maweni.

1. Social Impact

Fear of forced evictions has led to mental distress among residents, with families uncertain about their future. Community tensions have risen, with conflicts between long-term settlers and private developers creating a climate of mistrust and insecurity.

2. Economic and Developmental Impact

Forced into Homelessness – After the illegal evictions, many were left with nowhere to go. Jobless and desperate, some had to rent houses they could barely afford, while others relied on the mercy of relatives and friends, shattering their dignity and stability.

Debt burden – Families who took loans to build their homes were left drowning in financial ruin. With no compensation or recourse, they now struggle to survive under the weight of unpaid debts, with no way out.

Costly and Endless Legal Battles – The community has been fighting in court for years, but justice comes at a price. With limited resources, they are forced to scrape together funds for legal fees while the wealthy opponents exploit the system to drag out the case, knowing the poor will eventually run out of money.

Abandoned Generation – Some members have died, leaving behind orphans with no support. Without guidance or means, many have fallen into drugs and crime, not out of choice but sheer helplessness. The system has failed them twice: first by stealing their land, then by ignoring their suffering

Stolen Future – The community even paid survey fees of Ksh 15,000, only to watch in agony as outsiders occupied their land and erected high-rise buildings. They stand powerless, their poverty weaponized against them. **Justice has become a luxury only the rich can afford, while the poor are left to the cruelty of fate**

3. Legal and Governance Implications

The failure to enforce court rulings raises concerns about the credibility of the judiciary and the rule of law in land administration. The case highlights weak governance structures in land management, with multiple agencies failing to act decisively. If unresolved, the dispute sets a dangerous precedent for other settlements facing similar conflicts in Kilifi County and across Kenya.

5.0 CONCLUSION & RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 CONCLUSION

The fact-finding mission on the Maweni Settlement Scheme land dispute revealed deep-rooted land tenure insecurity, legal contradictions, and governance lapses that continue to affect the lives of residents. Despite a 2012 High Court ruling declaring parcels MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 as public land, enforcement has been lacking, creating room for private developers to stake conflicting claims. The failure to implement the 2017 National Land Commission (NLC) survey and the delays in issuing title deeds further exacerbated tensions, leaving settlers vulnerable to evictions, intimidation, and loss of livelihoods.

The dispute not only stalled development and economic progress but also exposed residents to potential human rights violations, including forced evictions, lack of access to fair administrative action, and exclusion from key decision-making processes. Additionally, weak enforcement of land policies and judicial rulings has led to continued land speculation, irregular allocations, and potential corruption.

Resolving this dispute requires decisive action from relevant government agencies, legal enforcement of court rulings, and structured community engagement to ensure that rightful occupants receive land tenure security. Below are the recommended short-term and long-term measures to address the issue.

5.2 RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the findings and analysis, the fact-finding mission proposed a series of short-term and long-term recommendations to resolve the Maweni land dispute effectively. These recommendations aimed to protect the rights of the affected community, ensuring legal compliance, and promotion of sustainable land use and management.

5.2.1 Short-Term Recommendations

1. Immediate Enforcement of the 2012 judgment & 2023 Court Ruling

The Ministry of Lands, the National Land Commission (NLC), and the Kilifi County Government should take immediate steps to uphold and implement the High Court ruling that declared the land public and the 2023 Malindi Court order that stopped further alienations, allocations, and issuance of title deeds.

The authority should monitor and ensure compliance with the ruling by all parties involved.

2. Protection Against Forced Evictions and Harassment

Law enforcement agencies, including the National Police Service and local authorities, must ensure that residents are protected from illegal evictions and intimidation by private developers.

Any reported instances of violence or harassment should be investigated and prosecuted without fear, favour or contradictions.

3. Public Awareness and Community Engagement

Sensitization forums should be conducted to educate residents on their land rights, the status of the court ruling, and the legal processes available to protect them.

The county government and civil society organizations should work together to amplify community voices and push for policy action.

4. Temporary Land Use Permits

The County Government of Kilifi should issue temporary land occupation permits to protect residents from unlawful evictions while long-term solutions are sought.

5. Audit of Land Transactions and Allocations

A thorough review of all land transactions related to MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 should be conducted by the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC) and the Directorate of Criminal Investigations (DCI) to uncover potential fraud or irregular allocations.

6. Formation of a Multi-Stakeholder Mediation Committee

A mediation team comprising of representatives from NLC, local leaders, community representatives, public administration officers, CSOs and legal experts should be established to facilitate dialogue and prevent escalations.

7. Revocation of the current community land committee

The committee that oversaw the land had four siblings (Omar Salim Chengo and Hussein Kitsao Chengo, Issa Juma Nimasumbi, and Juma Omar Nguma) and a mother and her daughter, Jane Muche and June Ruth. The committee had no representative for youth and women, or people with disabilities. The continual transaction on the parcel should be stopped.

8. Revocation of existing title deeds for MN/III/324 and MN/III/334

The existing title deeds for MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 should be revoked. The allocation was done irregularly, as some title deeds were awarded to individuals not on the beneficiaries' list, while excluding some Bonafide residents of Maweni. Revocation of the existing deeds will rectify the mistakes made.

5.2.2 Long-term recommendations

1. Land Regularization and Issuance of Title Deeds

The Ministry of Lands, NLC, and Kilifi County Government should fast-track the regularization process and issue title deeds to the rightful residents. A transparent, community-led process should be adopted to ensure equity and fairness in land allocation.

2. Legislative and Policy Reforms

Strengthen land governance laws to prevent future disputes by ensuring that court rulings are automatically enforced. Existing Land policies should be amended to prioritize community participation in land allocation and dispute resolution.

3. Creation of a Permanent Land Dispute Resolution Mechanism

Establish a Community Land Tribunal to handle land disputes efficiently and fairly at the local level. This will promote alternative dispute resolution mechanisms (mediation and arbitration) to avoid prolonged court battles.

4. Infrastructure Development and Social Protection Programs

Invest in essential services such as roads, water, health centers, and schools to improve the living conditions of the residents. A resettlement and compensation plan should be established for any households that may be relocated as part of the regularization process.

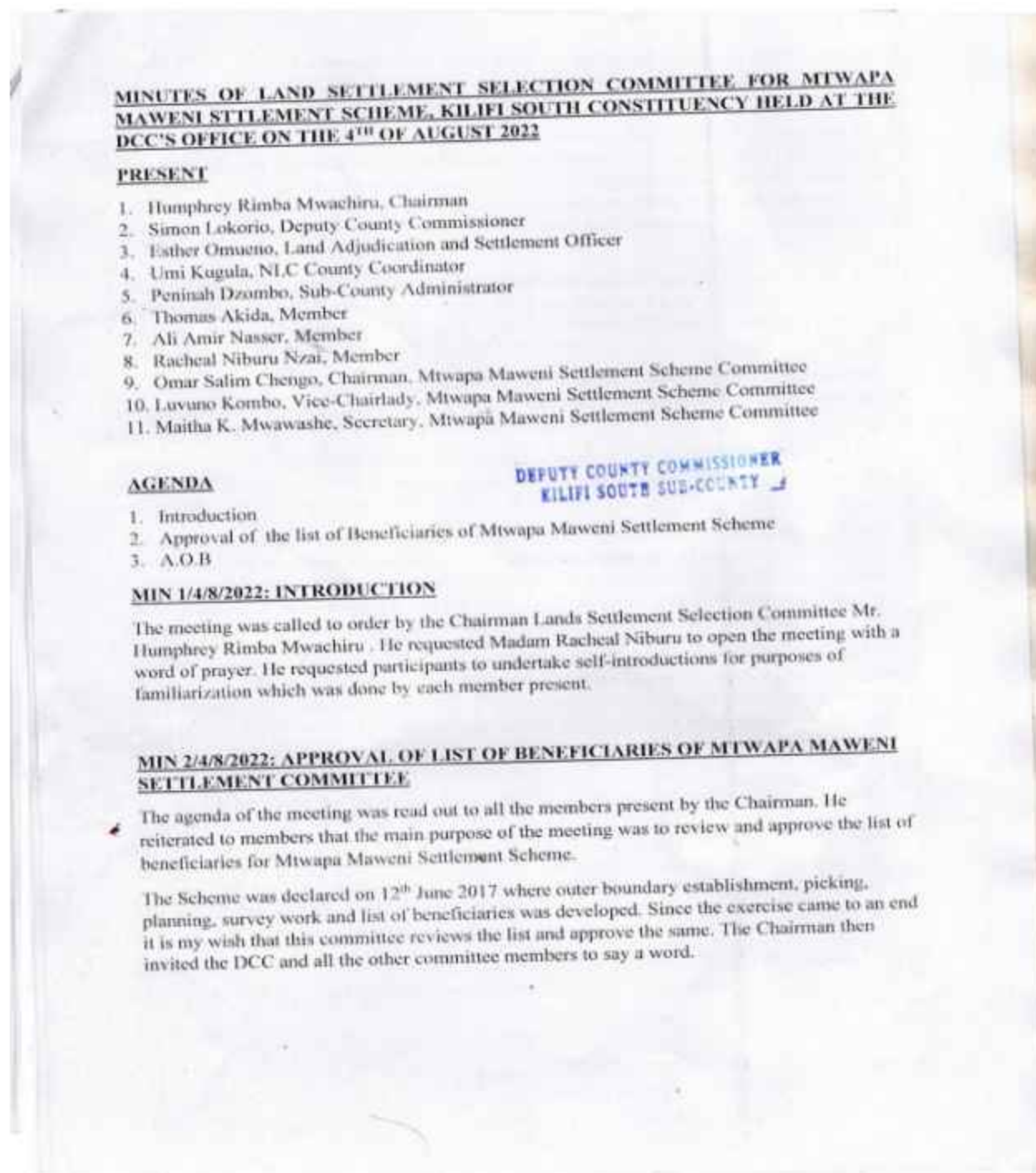
5. Strengthened Multi-Stakeholder Collaboration

Government agencies, civil society organizations, legal institutions, and community groups should work together to find a lasting solution to the dispute. Establish a monitoring and accountability

framework to ensure that all commitments made by the government and stakeholders are fulfilled transparent.

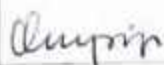

MIN 2/2018: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

- The Secretary Mr George Wanje read the Minutes of the previous meeting and the Chairman asked members if there is anyone with a question or clarifications to make. Through the Chairman, Mr Kenyatta Maitha picked the issue of verification and confirmation on the correctness of the names against the Plot Numbers identified by the Surveyors. He asked members to submit to him and the Secretary any necessary correction which needs to be reflected in the final List before Registration and Titling. Members agreed to provide their inputs after the end of the meeting. There being no any other issue regarding the minutes of the previous meeting, Ms Judith Rambaya moved to support the minutes and was Seconded by Margaret Luvuno. The Chairman thereby declared the minutes to have been adopted by the Committee of Maweni Settlement Scheme.

MIN/3/2018: CONCLUSION OF SURVEY AND SUB-DIVISION OF PLOT NO.MN/III/324 & 334 BY THE GOVERNMENT OF KENYA

- In setting this agenda up for discussion, The Secretary requested Mr Samuel Pekeshe Cheti, to update members about the Survey process. Mr Cheti confirmed to members that pursuant to the orders issued by the Land and Environment Division of the High Court of Kenya, Mombasa delivered on the 19th of April 2017, that in his opinion the Survey Office of the Government of Kenya has successfully done its part.
- He reiterated that even the areas that had not been surveyed have now been fully covered including roads and public utilities. He told members that in fact the Survey Plan has been dully approved by Survey Office.
- Mr Lawis Muchai reiterated the need for the Team Leader among the Surveyors to prepare a Survey Report to be filed in Court, since the Survey was complete. Moving in support of the idea Mr Albert Ngala Karisa in fact suggested that Lawis moves with urgency to file the report in Court once the Lead Surveyor hands it over to Mr Samuel Cheti.

MIN/4/2018: PHYSICAL ALLOCATION OF SUB-DIVIDED PLOTS TO OWNERS AS PER APPROVED SURVEY PLAN BY THE GOVERNMENT

- Mr. Iqbal Gitau asked members whether they have a formula on how land owners will be shown the boundaries of their plots. The Chairman rose to respond and reminded him that in the last two meetings a resolution had been adopted for the printing of special cards/ Ballots.
- He confirmed that the Ballots are ready and once verifies and confirmed they shall be given to owners to prevent cases of mistaken identity when showing plot owners the physical boundaries generated through the survey process.

RE: GRIEVANCES ON THE IMPROPER AND/OR MANIPULATED PROCESS OF ALLOCATION OF LAND PARCELS MN/III/324 & MN/III/334; MTWAPA, KILIFI COUNTY

WE THE UNDERSIGNED citizens of Kenya collectively comprising of beneficiaries and/or residents under the Maweni Settlement Scheme, Mtwapa, Kilifi South Constituency, within Kilifi County

DRAW the attention of the noble office of the Ministry of Lands & Physical Planning to the following:-

THAT WHEREAS, the court through its ruling dated 30/03/2012 decreed that land parcels number MN/III/324 and MN/III/334 Mtwapa is public land and residents should be settled thereon,

THAT pursuant to the court's declaration, the National Land Commission through its letter dated 6/07/2017 commenced preparations of the allocation of land to the residents of Maweni through the Maweni Settlement Scheme initiative

THAT a subsequent ground survey was done in the year 2018 or thereabout in a joint exercise involving National Land Commission County Coordinator together with the Ministry of Lands & Physical Planning officials of Kilifi County.

THAT the exercise did not yield the expected results for the following cited reasons:

- i. The Director of Surveys never furnished the residents with a survey plan clearly indicating the numbering of the land parcels for the purposes of generating individual titles;
- ii. The National Land Commission failed and/or neglected to vet the targeted allottees in the area;
- iii. The National Land Commission failed and/or neglected to oversee the allocation of the plots using for allocation using a fair and just process;
- iv. National Land Commission failed and/or neglected to issue letters of allotment to qualified allottees

THAT due to the abovementioned flaws in the process of allocation of land to the residents, the residents have suffered the following consequences:

- a. The residents have not been able to submit letters to NLC accepting the offer and the conditions of allotment;
- b. Failed to make payment of the statutory fees required in the letter of allotment;
- c. Failed to ensure individual plot files have been opened by the NLC and note the numbers;
- d. After the ground survey was conducted the surveyor failed and/or neglected to show the beacons of the individual plots;
- e. The residents were never issued with a beacon certificate;
- f. Since the bungled survey was conducted in 2018, the County Land Administrator has failed and/or neglected to re-confirm the ground status through ascertainment of rights and interests of the residents vis a vis the individual land parcels;

THAT, inspite the mentioned flaws, the residents are astounded to establish the fact that the County Land Administrators have issued individual title deeds to unscrupulous dealers.

THAT we are aware that a committee with a membership of seven people was established in Maweni; whereas the committee was created to facilitate land re-settlement of all landless people in the area, on the contrary, the committee has allocated most of the land to members themselves, their family members, relatives and friends as well as foreigners at the expense of more than 1,400 residents who are landless.

THAT whereas the committee was set up to facilitate the landless to be resettled, there has emerged an agency operating for rich people from Maweni area and other areas willing to buy land from the region at some fee.

THAT we confirm that efforts have been made to have the matter addressed by the relevant offices and failed to elicit any response thereon.

THAT WHEREAS, we appreciate that the solutions offered in this petition are not exhaustive to totally take care of the situation in the area, in our humble opinion these are the immediate measures that the your noble office ought to initiate;

HEREFORE, your humble Petitioners PRAY that your noble office intervenes and ensures that:-

- a. cancellation of all title deeds which have been irregularly issued;
- b. investigates the matter with a view to establishing genuine squatters;
- c. proper re-survey and process of allocation of the parcels of land to ensure concerned residents are issued with parcel numbers and offer letters;
- d. issuance of title deeds in an equitable manner to the residents.

And we will forever pray.
